

Notes on Rivington Chapel COVID measures for services from 28 February 2022

A revised risk assessment has been written following the removal of all legal restrictions on 24 February 2022

COVID-19 guidance from the Government with regards to Places of Worship was updated on 25 February 2022. The revised risk assessment reflects the changes introduced in that guidance.

What the Chapel is doing to help you stay safe

- Hand sanitiser will still be available on entry/exit from the Chapel
- The main doors will be open before/after services to provide as much ventilation as possible, although this will be weather dependent
- All surfaces that are touched regularly will be cleaned

What you can do to help yourself and other stay safe

- Please do not attend the service if you or a household member are showing any symptoms of COVID-19
- Please consider the welfare of others and not just your own
 - It is still recommended that face coverings are worn in crowded and enclosed spaces
 - Check with others before approaching closely or sharing a pew
 - Ensure that there is space for others to pass if standing in the aisles
